Dear Fuzzy Faces Refuge Riders, Volunteers and Participants;

As the World Health Organization declares COVID-19 to be a pandemic, we want everyone to be aware of the steps we are taking to ensure the safety of all who are involved with our programs.

Currently, the scheduled sessions will occur as usual. If this changes, you will be notified immediately. **Please know that of particular concern is for our riders and/or volunteers with weakened immune systems or family members in the same household.**

We are increasing the cleaning and disinfecting of tack, surfaces, equipment and props to try to avoid any potential contamination.

We are asking:

- If you have been traveling recently to infected areas, please stay home.

- If you are showing any signs of sickness, i.e. cough, fever, runny nose, etc., please stay home.

- If you have a weakened immune system and are worried about contracting this illness, please stay home.

Please notify me if you plan on staying home. Your safety and health are of the utmost importance and every precaution is with that in mind. We will include some extra weeks to allow for make ups and will move the next session block to a later date to be determined.
